Folkestone Town Council (FTC) are asking residents and people working in Folkestone to complete a survey as part of a review of the priorities for the Town Council to deliver on over the next four years.

The Corporate Plan governs the Council's objectives and how it delivers them - to improve the quality of life for all Folkestone residents, businesses and visitors to our town, developing and underpinning its identity. It outlines the Town Council's mission, vision, purpose, objectives and values with targets and key performance indicators to help the Council assess progress against our shared objectives.

At the most local tier of local government, FTC want to hear the views of residents to help make Folkestone a better place to live and work.

The survey should take about 10 minutes to complete and must be submitted by 12 noon on 19 September 2024, when all views and comments will be considered.
