TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Beachborough Road, Folkestone will be closed to through traffic, on or after 28th January 2021 for up to 1 day.

The road will be closed between the junctions of B2064 Cheriton Road and Limes Road.

The alternative route is via Shorncliffe Road, B2063 Risborough Lane, B2064 Cheriton High Street, B2064 Cheriton Road and vice versa.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 09:30 and 15:30 hrs.

This closure is necessary to enable restoration of customers services to be carried out by BT Openreach.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
