DYKE ROAD, FOLKESTONE

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Dyke Road, Folkestone will be closed to through traffic, on or after 28th January 2021 for up to 2 days.

The road will be closed between the junctions of The Durlocks and East Cliff.

The alternative route is via The Durlocks, East Cliff Gardens, East Cliff Passage, East Cliff, Dyke Road and vice versa.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 09:00 and 16:00 hrs each day.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway patching to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
