TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Fleming Way, Folkestone will be closed to through traffic, on or after 26th January 2021 for up to 8 days.

The road will be closed outside 2 Fleming Way.

The one-way system will be rescinded to allow access.

The alternative route is via George Gurr Crescent, Montgomery Way, Brabner Close and Fleming Way.

This closure is necessary to enable cabling works to be carried out by UK Power Networks.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
