**SHORNCLIFFE ROAD, FOLKESTONE**

**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2021**

To allow high-friction resurfacing works to be carried out at a junction to improve road safety, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Shorncliffe Road, Folkestone.

An overnight closures is planned for Friday 26 March 2021 from 19:00 hours through until approximately 05:00 hours.

**SHORNCLIFFE ROAD** will be closed at and including the junction with junction with Audley Road, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative route for all through traffic is via Risborough Way, B2063 Risborough Lane, Military Road, A259 Sandgate High Street, Sandgate Hill, Sandgate Road, Earls Avenue and B2064 Shorncliffe Road, and vice versa.

**AUDLEY ROAD** will be closed at the junction with Shorncliffe Road, with access to the remainder of the road continuing from Cooling Lane.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
