The Town Council has a Planning Committee that has delegated authority to make comments and representations on behalf of the Council, the committee meets three weekly to consider and respond to planning applications and consultations within the statutory time frame.

The Town Council works proactively wherever possible to strengthen and improve relationships with community groups, local organisations, businesses, statutory bodies, voluntary groups, borough and county councils. For example, hosting public engagement events at the Town Hall.

Folkestone Community Magazine enables the Town Council to engage with registered electors to gain an insight into local opinion.
