BATHURST ROAD, FOLKESTONE

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to replace a sewer manhole frame and cover, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Bathurst Road, Folkestone.

A closure is currently planned for Wednesday 7 April 2021 from 09:00 hours for an estimated period of up to 6 hours. In the event of any issues, there might need to be a repeat closure the following day.

Bathurst Road will be closed at the junction with Baldric Road

Access to the remainder of Bathurst Road continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Coolinge Lane, Audley Road, Baldric Road and Welson Road.

Baldric Road will be closed at the junction with Bathurst Road, with access to the remainder of the road continuing from Audley Road

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
