TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Castle Hill Avenue - Northbound, Folkestone will be closed to through traffic, on or after 9th June 2021 for up to 3 days.

The road will be closed at the junctions of Bouverie Road West and Shorncliffe Road.

The alternative route is via Bouverie Road West, Earls Avenue and Shorncliffe Avenue.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 19.00 hrs and 05.00 hrs each day.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway patching to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
