TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Coolinge Lane, Folkestone will be closed to through traffic, on or after 6th April 2021 for up to 2 days.

The road will be closed between the junctions of Sandgate Hill and Bathurst Road.

The alternative route is via Sandgate Hill, Grimston Avenue, Shorncliffe Road and Coolinge Lane.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 09:00 and 16:00 hrs each day.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway patching to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
