**PARK FARM ROAD, FOLKESTONE**

**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2020**

**To allow works to be carried out to update and replace traffic calming measures, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Park Farm Road, Folkestone.**

**A continuous closure is currently planned from Monday 26 October 2020 for an estimated period 5 days.**

**Park Farm Road will be closed between the junctions with Alder Road and Trinity Drive, to the extent indicated on site.**

**The alternative route for through traffic is via Park Farm Road, A259 Churchill Avenue, Canterbury Road, Black Bull Road and Radnor Park Road (Pavilion Road in opposite direction).**

**Local access to the remainder of Park Farm Road continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.**

**Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.**
