FOLKESTONE RACE FOR LIFE

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow the Cancer Research UK Folkestone Race for Life Charity Event to be held on the highway, Kent County Council has made an Order to restrict traffic on certain roads in The Leas area of Folkestone.

The following roads will be closed on Sunday 12 September 2021, between 10:30 hours and 14:00 hours, as defined below:

- **CLIFF ROAD** – closed for its entire length
- **DIXWELL ROAD** – closed from the junction with Sandgate Road southwards for its entire length
- **METROPOLE ROAD WEST** – closed for its entire length
- **METROPOLE ROAD EAST** – closed for its entire length
- **THE LEAS** – closed from the junction with Metropole East to the junction with Metropole West
- **CLIFTON GARDENS** – closed for its entire length

The alternative route for all through traffic is via West Terrace, Bouverie Place, Bouverie Square, Middelburg Square, Bouverie Road West, Castle Hill Avenue and Sandgate Road.

There will also be a suspension of parking on The Leas (between the junctions with Metropole Road East and Metropole Road West) from 08:00 and 14:00.

This Order applies when the relevant signs, barriers and No Waiting cones are on site. The restrictions will be lifted as soon as possible after the event has finished.

Local arrangements will be in place to allow managed access for residents and businesses, when safe to do so.
