TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that St Michaels Street, Folkestone will be closed to through traffic, on or after 16th November 2020 for up to 3 days.

The road will be closed between 1-4 Sherwood Trust Homes and the one-way section.

The alternative route is via Harvey Street, Harbour Way and St Michaels Street.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 09:00 and 16:00 hrs each day.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway investigation works to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
