Consultation on Statement of Principles for Gambling Gambling Act 2005

The council is required to have a written Statement of Principles setting out its approach and expectations as a licensing authority under the Gambling Act 2005. The statement must be reviewed every 3 years.

A draft revised statement is now open for consultation and can be viewed at https://www.folkestone-hythe.gov.uk/gambling/licenses-permits

The Statement has been updated based on current guidance from the Gambling Commission. The draft does not represent any significant change in approach to our current statement. Key amendments are as follows:

- General update of references and area descriptions
- Gambling Prevalence Statistics updated with the latest NHS study 2019
- Clarification of the meaning of 'available for use' for access to gaming machine
- Update on the limits on the number of Category B gaming machines

It is anticipated that the revised statement will be presented to Full Council at the end of March 2022, to come into effect in April 2022.
