Folkestone Town Council is committed to providing an opportunity for the community to state its views and provide information regarding how people feel about where they live.

The Town Council has a Planning Committee that has delegated authority to make comments and representations on behalf of the Council, the Committee meets monthly to consider and respond to planning applications and consultations with the statutory time frame.

Agendas are available via our website and applications can be viewed via a public kiosk in the foyer of the Town Hall.

The Town Council works proactively wherever possible to strengthen and improve relationships with community groups, local organisations, businesses, statutory bodies, voluntary groups, Borough and County Councils. For example, hosting public engagement events at the Town Hall.

Folkestone Community Magazine enables the Town Council to engage with registered electors to gain an insight into local opinion.

- Have a clear method in which the public can give feedback to the Council both positive, negative and with ideas for development.
- Promote communication via the website, noticeboards, public participation at meetings, questionnaires, Annual Report and Community Magazine.
- Manage the Council's resources to ensure that they are spent on the needs of the community.
- Focus resources on what matters to our community and those that visit the area.
- Continue to comment on proposed planning applications and developments.
